



Spa Cover Measurement Guide

Use this guide before entering dimensions for a custom replacement spa cover.

Pegasus Spas partners with one of the industry's leading spa cover manufacturers to provide custom-built replacement covers for virtually any spa.

Because covers are built specifically from the measurements provided at the time of order, all dimensions should be verified before submitting your order - even if your spa was originally purchased from Pegasus Spas.

Where Should I Measure?

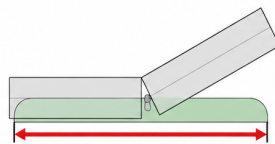
Measure your spa at the widest points based on the style of cabinet shown below.

Where Should I Measure?

Measure your spa at the widest points based on the installation type that best matches your spa.

- **No cabinet lip/rail**

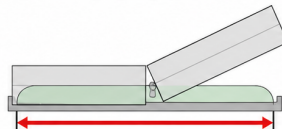
Measure across the acrylic edge.



Measure straight across the widest point on the acrylic edge.

- **With cabinet lip/rail**

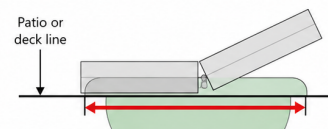
Measure across the widest outside points of the cabinet rail.



Measure straight across the widest outside points of the rail.

- **In-ground/deck spas**

Measure across the widest points above ground level.



Measure straight across the widest points above ground level.



Always measure as shown above and round measurements **UP** to the nearest inch.
A cover that is slightly larger will fit better than one that is too small.

- **No cabinet lip/rail:** Measure across the acrylic edge.
- **With a cabinet lip/rail:** Measure across the widest outside points of the rail.
- **In-ground/deck spas:** Measure across the widest points above ground/deck level.

How Should I Measure?

- Measure each dimension at the widest point.
- Round all measurements **UP** to the nearest inch.
- Covers that are slightly oversized generally fit better than covers that are too small.

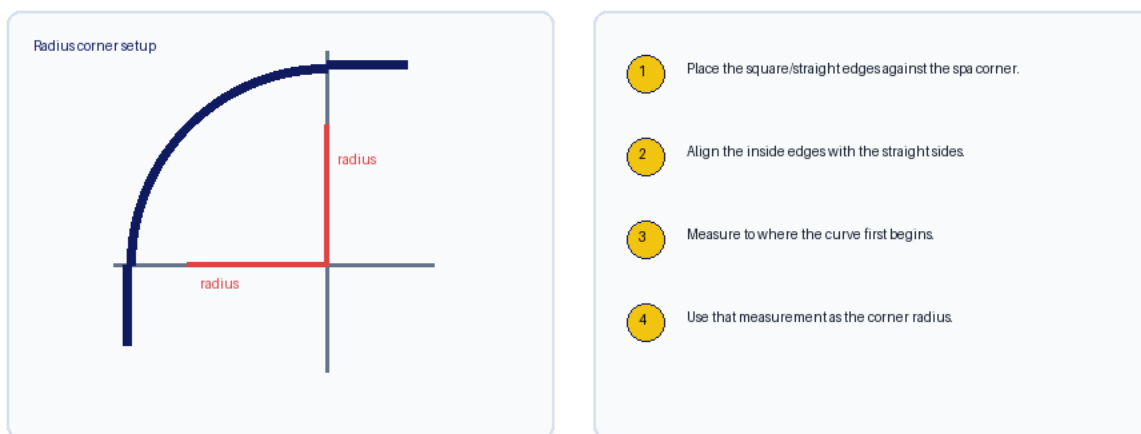
Important - Fold Direction

- The fold, or center hinge, always cuts the "A" dimension in half.
- In most cases this is the longest dimension, but not always.
- Verify the fold direction carefully before submitting your order.

How to Measure Radius Corners

If your selected spa shape has rounded corners, the radius measurement helps the cover manufacturer match the curve of the spa.

- The most accurate way to measure a spa cover radius is using a carpenter's square or two straight edges.
- Place the square against the corner of the spa so the inside edges align with the straight sides of the spa cabinet.
- Measure from the corner point to where the curve first begins.
- This measurement is your radius.
